New Feature

Runes

Runes are an ancient North European form of writing, with their origins shrouded in mystery. Which is quite appropriate as the very word RUNE means: a secret. Although there are theories, no single theory, that I have read, explains their emergence to my satisfaction. My thoughts are that there was a more Northern pictorial and symbolic form of writing which merged with Etruscan writing as tribes traded up and down the Rhine. Leading to the formation of a runic alphabet around the 1st or 2nd centuries ad. By the time the Roman general Tacitus wrote of them, their use was widespread. However he does not mention of the number of runes used, so it is unsafe to draw any conclusions as to which, if any, of the known Futharks he was describing.

Runes were in common usage for about 800 years, From Finland to Newfoundland in some places they lasted in use till the 1200s before being replaced by Latin writing. This though has more to do with the rise of Christianity and wholesale religious cleansing by the Catholic Church. Runes were seen as a remnant of the old pagan religions of Northern Europe and the Church did its best to obliterate them. Though there is also evidence from coins and crosses on graves that the two forms of writing did co-exist for some time.

Indeed when Iceland officially converted to Christianity there was a provision in the law that you could still follow the 'old religion' in the privacy of your own home. It was on the basis of this law, some 800 years later, that Asatru was started as a religious movement and now has a temple in Reykjavik.

Modern Heathenry has much of its symbolism in the runes. Fehu shows us that we must work for what we wish to gain. There is no divine handout. Gebo, Ehwaz and Mannaz can all be seen as symbols of our Troth. Pertho can relate to the Norns; Ansuz, Thurisaz, Tyr, and Inguz are all closely linked to various of our Gods.

On a personal level I was using Runes, long before I became pagan, let alone Heathen. They have a subtle power. The longer I used them the more appreciation I had for them. This led to me researching more of their background and that proved to be the first step on the road to me becoming heathen. Though sometimes it occurs to me that I was a Heathen all along, but I just didn't know it.

Letter from Rev. Don Lewis

Greetings all!

Once again the Lustration of the Living has come and gone, and we look back with pleasure upon a wonderful Lustration weekend.

This year's Lustration of the Living was held in Vermilion County Illinois -homeland of the Correllian Tradition –with events at the new Witcheschool Headquarters in Rossville, at Hesychia House of Contemplation in Rossville, and at the Ritual Grounds of Rev. Kim Anders, former Head of Enchanted Realm Temple, in Danville.

People came from across the country to attend the ceremony. Notably Rev. Alyssa Maxon led two truckloads of members of her Spiral Light Shrine across country from Connecticut, Rev. Christina Dunn and her daughter came up from Arkansas, and Rev. Jaqueline deGraaf came from Washington state, while others attended from Wisconsin, Ohio, Tennessee, Georgia, and throughout Illinois.

On Thursday and Friday Rev. Jaqueline de Graaf conducted a Life Passages class in the library/classroom of the new Witch School Headquarters in Rossville, Illinois.

On Friday night a Crystal Ball was held at Hesychia House, featuring vegan, meat, and seafood paellas and homemade bread.

This was followed by a Drumming Circle at the ritual grounds of Rev. Kim Anders, former Head of Enchanted Realm Temple.

Saturday began bright and early with Temple Deemings in the Temple room at Hesychia House at 10 AM. Six groups were up for Deeming in this session: Dreaming Dragon of Texas, Sanctuaire du Corbeau of Quebec, Sacred Sea of Georgia, Lady of Light Sister Circle of Arkansas, Northern Lakes of Wisconsin, and Sekhmet of Ontario. Of these six groups, half were represented in person with Rev. Stephanie Neal of Sacred Sea, Rev. Peter Hertzberg of Northern Lakes, and Rev. Christina Dunn of Lady of Light all present.

After the Deemings a picnic followed on the grounds of Hesychia House, followed by a Message Circle led by First Priestess Lady Krystel.

Saturday evening we repaired back to Rev. Kim's ritual grounds for several hours of initiations.

Sunday morning we all gathered at Hesychia House before heading out to Rev. Kim's Ritual Grounds for the Lustration itself. Rev. Kim's Ritual Ground is a very beautiful wooded area with a permanent ritual circle marked out with sections from a tree felled by lightning, and decorated with many pieces of lovely artwork. A tent had been set up for

the feast afterward, with the buffet set up in a screened-in gazebo.

The ceremonies began with Lady Kim and Lady Bitterwind leading a procession to the river, which runs through the Ritual Ground, and collecting the water for the ceremony. Rev. Alyssa of Spiral Light Witan Shrine had also brought water to be added to the Lustral Cauldron, which was added during the ceremony.

Then we processed to the Ritual Circle for the Lustration itself. Paladin Rev. Zack Parker acted as Guardian, issuing the ritual challenge before the entry procession. Because the ritual circle is sized for ordinary Temple use, only those with speaking parts entered the actual circle and others filled in around it.

First Priestess Lady Krystel and First Priest Lord Don cleansed and charged the circle themselves, starting the ceremony.

Rev. Reanna Marie HP, Head of Enchanted Realm Temple, acted as Sonifer, while Rev. Aine Massie HP, Head of Crystalline Star Temple, acted as Vocifer.

Rev. Jaqueline deGraaf and Rev. Christina Dunn, Head of Lady of Light Sister Circle, acted as Junovocator and Genevocator, offering invocations to the Higher Self.

The Quarters were called with the Invocation of the Seventy Gods. Rev. Jennifer, Brandi, Elizabeth Bull, and Rev. Alyssa Maxon Head of Spiral Light Shrine acted as Quarter Guardians.

Elizabeth Bull also acted as Deaf Interpreter for the ceremony –for which we are most grateful.

Next followed the Great Rite. Rev. Debbe Tompkins HP, Head of the Order of Hesychia, and Rev. Peter Hertzberg, Head of Northern Lakes Shrine, acted as Rite Priest and Priestess with Rev. Steff Neal HP, Head of Sacred Sea acting as Rite Lector.

This seasons Oracle was among our most remarkable ever, with the message being that Dawn has come to the Day of the Great Work.

Lady Bitterwind then led the actual Lustration. Lady Bitterwind was assisted by Rev. Robert deMaille acting as Elders Herald.

During the Toast Lady Bitterwind and Lady Reanna sang their song “One Step More” – the lyrics for which can be found at www.correllian.com/songs.htm

Then the Chancellor made announcements, as has become customary. Among the announcements: Dreaming Dragon Proto-Temple of Texas, under Rev. Joy Dupnik HP, has been Deemed a Full Temple: Sanctuaire du Corbeau, of Quebec, Canada, under Rev. Mishka Mayana, has been Deemed a Full Temple:

Sacred Sea Witan Shrine of Georgia, under Rev. Stephanie Neal HP, has been Deemed a Full Temple: Lady of Light Sister Circle of Arkansas, under Rev. Christina Dunn, has been Deemed a Full Temple: Northern Lakes Witan Shrine of Wisconsin, under Rev. Peter Hertzberg, has been Deemed a Proto-Temple: Sekhmet Witan Shrine of Ontario, Canada, under Rev. Mary Keller HP, has been Deemed as a Proto-Temple. Congratulations to all these groups and their members!

Lady Joy of Dreaming Dragon and Lady Stephanie of Sacred Sea, being of High Priestly status, now take seats on the Witan Council.

In addition Rev. Karla Summers, HP, and Rev. Windy LaJoie, HP, were appointed to the Witan as Notable Members of the Tradition, and charged with the specific duty of representing members of the Tradition unaffiliated with specific Temples.

Congratulations to Lady Joy, Lady Karla, Lady Stephanie, and Lady Windy!

Only one award was given in this cycle: The Order of the Golden Wand was given to Rev. Azriel for her many services to the Correlian people. Congratulations Rev. Azriel!

After the Lustration ceremony we all enjoyed the feast laid out by Lady Kim, and then people began to wend their various ways back home, bearing in their hearts the memories of a wonderful weekend.

Thank you to everyone for making this such a special event!

I would especially like to thank Lady Kim for hosting the Lustration ceremony at her Ritual Ground and Lady Debbe for hosting many of the Lustration events at Hesychia House of Contemplation.

The next Lustration will be the Lustration of the Ancestors in the Spring, which will be hosted by Rev. Anna Rowe HP, of Sedna Temple. This will be the first Lustration to be held outside of the US: in Carlton-Colville, Suffolk, UK. You can see the official site at <http://klik.to/lustration>
